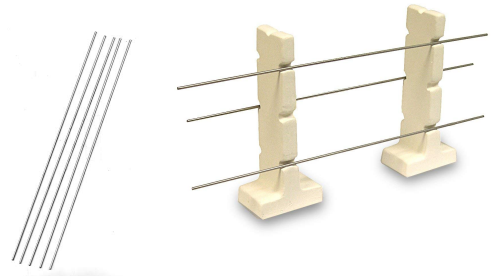


Hello Ceramic Jewelry Makers!

To ensure a productive and organized class, you may consider getting a few specific tools....

Provided: One HIGH FIRE bead rod for firing beads in the kiln will be provided for each student upon the first class. If you would like to purchase an additional jewelry rods, they can be bought in the Community Center office. We will teach you how to make a rack and different systems for setting up a custom bead rack.



Samples of Nichrome wire (aka Fire Wire, the same type of metal used for kiln elements), used for complex jewelry pieces, will also be available but in limited quantities. For your own use, we recommend you purchase additional or different gauges of Nichrome wire.
