

Sonoma Community Center is monitoring the COVID-19 situation and putting procedures in place to keep our camp attendees and staff safe. Below are a few safety measures that are planned for Sonoma Community Center's Summer Camp in 2021 **at this time**. Please note that this is not a full list and may be subject to change:

- Campers will split into social distance pods of 12 students.
- Camp staff will wear masks at all times when in the presence of campers.
- Camp attendees are to wear masks inside buildings and when instructed by camp staff. When outside with enough space, attendees will be able to remove their masks.
- Social distancing will be maintained.
- Attendees will be instructed to wash and sanitize hands throughout the day.
- Staff and attendees will be screened daily, using temperature checks and health questions regarding symptoms and exposure.
