### SUPPLY LIST

(Note: Bring any of the following. If you have none of them, don't worry. There are supplies in the studio that you can use.)

**Inspiration/Subject Matter:** Sketches, pictorial images, or small object

#### **Sketchbook**

**Paint:** Your choice of medium – acrylic, gouache, or oil are suggested; watercolor is possible. Recommended that you bring a warm and a cool of each primary hue to start with, but if you aren't equipped or want to just start with a tube of black and a tube of white to begin a tonal study that's okay. If these are terms that are unfamiliar to you, don't panic, they will be explained in class as needed.

**Brushes,** and/or sponges, twigs, rollers, mark-making device

**Pallet** and/or cat food tins and **pallet knife**

**Container** for water or solvent

**Substrate:** Stretched canvas, cradled panel, door skin, Masonite, or other surface

**Paper towels or rags** – or a plastic drop cloth if you are an abstract expressionist

**Portable easel,** if you have one (optional)
