SUPPLY LIST (Note: participants receive a 10% discount at Fine Line Art Supply, Sonoma)

There are many choices when it comes to art supplies as you will find. As with any market, there are big differences in quality and prices. Try to move toward the best quality paints, canvas, and brushes as you can afford them and have confidence in their use. Cheap quality materials will only frustrate and distract you from your creative experience.

- Oil Paint: Look for pigment ground in refined linseed oil. Stay away from water mixable and alkyd oil paints for this course.
 - o Titanium White in Linseed Oil – you will need a large tube of white 150 ml to 250 ml size, avoid whites in safflower oil if you can, they dry too slowly.
 - o Yellow – Cadmium or a primary yellow that is semi-transparent.
 - o Blue – Ultramarine, Pthalo, Cerulean, or Cobalt – any one of these will do.
 - o Cobalt Teal
 - o Quinacridone Magenta
 - o Red – Cadmium Medium or Naphthol Red
 - o Yellow Ochre
 - o Burnt Sienna or Burnt Umber
- Canvas Panels or Stretched Canvas for Oil - 9" x 12" is best for these classes.
- Brushes, Bristle – 2 long flats 3/4 to 1" wide & 2 flats 1/2" wide, 2 filberts not smaller than the flats, 2 small rounds diameter.
- Palette Knife, Metal – for mixing on palette and painting.
- Wet Painting Carrier – Select one for the size of canvas or panels you will be working with. Good choices are Raymar or PanelPak <https://www.panelpak.com/> and <https://www.raymarart.com/>

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- Paper Palette Pad – 12” x 16” gray or white. This size is the standard you will need and fits perfectly in the palette box.
- Palette Box – Masterson Palette Seal for 12” x 16” palette pads to transport wet paint mixtures away from class.
- Palette Cup(s) – get the style that clips to the edge of the palette, lidded is not necessary.
- Refined Linseed Oil – a small bottle
- Safflower Oil – 1 liter size from grocery for cleaning brushes
- Brush Washer – Stainless steel with snap on lid seal for the safflower oil. We will not be cleaning with solvents in this class.
- Paper Towels – 1 roll for class, buy a package.
- Dirty Towel Bag – like doggy doo bags
- Apron – Paint clothing
- Nitrile Gloves – optional
- Sketch Book
- Charcoal pencil
- Bag or Rolling transporter to carry all this stuff. There is nowhere to store your materials and supplies in the community center classrooms.

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
